## Honolulu Area Transit Map

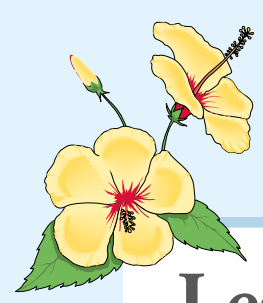

- 42 Major Suburban Route**  
Connecting outlying island communities to Central Honolulu via primary corridors. Most routes operate every day, with service all day long.
- 88 Local Route**  
All-day service linking residential neighborhoods to key destinations and other transit routes.
- Commuter Route**  
Operating during peak hours, with direct service between residential areas and activity centers.
